***Curate Your Heartache* Submission Requirements and Details**

Please read the entirety of the document below before delivering your work.

About

The San Jose Institute of Contemporary Art (ICA) and Social Policy invite artists and non-artists alike to participate in a collaborative community group exhibition *Curate Your Heartache*. *Curate Your Heartache* will be an exhibition of personal objects and mementos from current or past romantic relationships. The exhibition will be held at Social Policy, located at 200 S 1st St, San Jose, CA 95113 from February 1st (exhibition's Opening Reception) through February 24th, 2019. All are invited to submit an item for the exhibition.

Curate Your Heartache is the first **Art Hangs** event, the ICA's newest program that brings you FREE off-site participatory pop-up art experiences.

Requirements

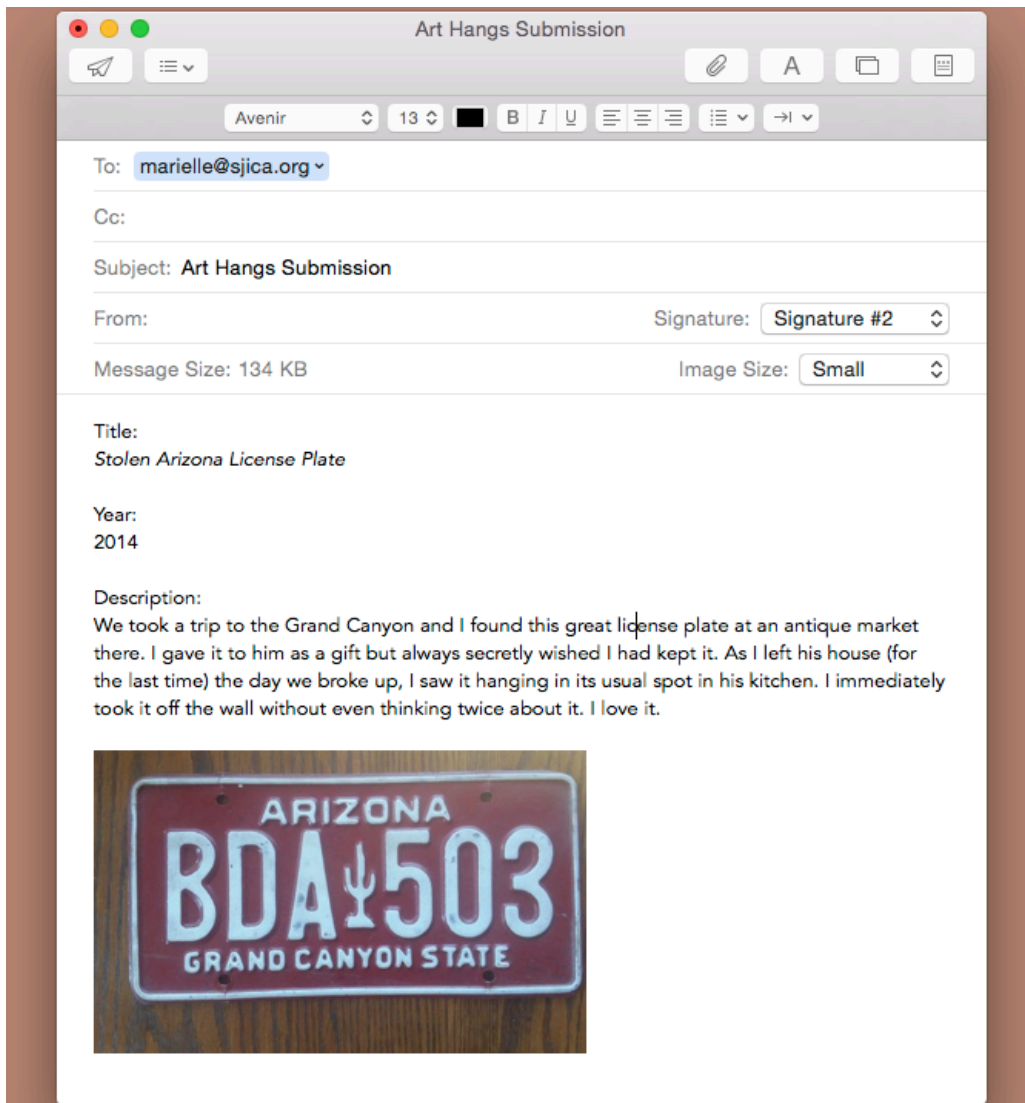
- All items must be hand delivered to the ICA or Social Policy during the drop off schedule below (see below for details). We will not accept items before or after the drop off schedule.
- All items must be labeled with the owner's name and phone number at time of drop-off so it may be safely ready for pick-up at the end of the exhibition.
- You must email marielle@sjica.org with an image of your item (does not need to be high-res), a title, the year it came into your possession, and a 3-5 sentence description of your object for a descriptive wall label that will hang alongside your item (see below for an example). We will not include your name on the label for anonymity.
- Two-dimensional (flat) items must be ready to be hang on the wall (wire, d-rings, or cleat) and cannot exceed 24 x 24 inches. Three-dimensional items cannot exceed 24 x 24 x 24 inches. If your item is larger than those dimensions, please send email marielle@sjica.org so we can try to accommodate your item.
- The items will be displayed in a café gallery, with audiences of all ages, demographics, and backgrounds; therefore, the ICA and Social Policy reserve the right to turn away any work that is graphic or inappropriate.
- You will be required to sign a waiver upon delivery of the item.
- If your item does not meet these requirements, it will be turned away upon delivery.

How to participate

- 1) **Drop-off** item with name and phone number at ICA (560 S 1st Street, San Jose) or Social Policy (200 S 1st St, San Jose, CA 95113) during listed drop off times (**see below**).
- 2) Email marielle@sjica.org with the subject heading: “Art Hangs Submission” with an image of your object, a title, the year it came into your possession, and a 3-5 sentence description of the item. See example below.
- 3) **Attend the Opening Reception** at Social Policy on February 1st from 7PM-10PM.
- 4) **Attend Anti-Valentine’s Day Happy Hour** at Social Policy on February 14th from 5PM- 8PM.
- 5) **Pick-up your item** at the end of the exhibition from Social Policy on February 24th (see below).

Delivery details

All accepted objects must be hand-delivered to either the **ICA between Friday, January 11 and Wednesday, January 23, 2019 (see below for details)** OR items may be hand-delivered to Social Policy on either **January 19 or January 20, between 3-6PM.**

- **ICA: Hand-delivered artwork may be dropped off January 11-23, between 10AM and 5PM only (Tuesday - Friday) or 12PM and 5PM (weekends). The ICA is closed on Mondays, so please do not deliver your item on Monday January 14 and Monday January 21.**
- **Social Policy:** If you cannot make it to the ICA, there will be two drop-off dates at Social Policy. You may either deliver items to Social Policy on **January 19 or January 20, between 3-6PM.**

PLEASE NOTE: We will not accept items before or after the drop off schedule. **Items that are not picked up by March 1st will be thrown away (please see below for pick-up details).**
