In conjunction with the 39th Connect & Collect Auction, the ICA will also present **Bryon Ryono: Polybelisks**, an exhibition of unique bronze sculptures . The proceeds from the sale of these wonderful works will support the ongoing contemporary art programs and exhibitions at the ICA. **Bryon Ryono: Polybelisks** will be on view from September 28 – October 20. The work is available to take home at the time of purchase.

An **Opening Reception** for the Auction Exhibition will be held on **Sunday**, **October 6 from 1pm to 4pm**. The reception is free to attend and is open to the public. Guests will have the opportunity to meet many of the participating artists, view the exhibition and bid on silent auction works.

The Silent Auction will be held on Saturday, October 12, 5pm – 8pm. This highly popular event features a vibrant mix of works in a variety of media that will excite novice and veteran art collectors alike. Artworks are available at all price points. The first auction lot closes at 6:15 pm and the last auction lot closes at 7:15 pm. Admission to the party is free. Beer and wine will be available to purchase. Bidder cards are \$50 and can be purchased at the event or on the ICA website. Ticket holders to the Live Auction also receive a complimentary Silent Auction bidder card.

The Live Auction Gala, one of the Bay Area's most anticipated cultural events of the year, will be held on Saturday, October 26. Doors open at 5pm and the auction begins promptly at 6pm. Complimentary champagne, wine, beer, heavy hors d'oeuvres, and desserts will be served. Admission to the Live Auction – always a sellout event -- is reserved for ticket holders. Tickets are \$125 in advance and \$150 after October 25 and at the door. ICA members at the \$250 level and above are eligible to receive complimentary tickets to both the Silent Auction and Live Auction events.
